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To promote professional development, empowerment, and leadership among women practitioners, BMA and 12 other full-service law firms in Brazil joined forces to launch the Aliança Jurídica pela Equidade de Gênero (Legal Alliance for Gender Equity), which will direct special attention to supporting Black women, women of the LGBTQAIPN+ community, and women with disabilities.

The initiative will foster collaborative efforts among the law firms, focusing on raising awareness and literacy, combating unconscious biases, engaging male allies, exchanging experiences, and sharing best practices.
